Dr C. Fassoulas is curator of the Geological and Paleontological collections at the Natural History Museum of the University of Crete, Greece since 1996 and since 2004 teaches also at the Science and Technology School of the University of Crete as a Laboratory Teaching staff. He holds a diploma in geology and a PhD thesis in structural geology and neotectonics from the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki. His main scientific and research topics deal with geodynamics and tectonics of Aegean; tectonic geomorphology in modern orogenic zones; Natural risk mitigation; and geoconservation.

C.F. is the Scientific Coordinator of Psiloritis Geopark, a member of UNESCO Global geoparks, and member of EGN Coordination committee since 2001. He acts as geoparks evaluator for UNESCO since 2006; is Vice Coordinator of European Geoparks Network; Vice catalyst of Geohazards working group of GGN; Coordinator of Hellenic UNESCO Geoparks Forum; and Member of the Committee on Geoparks of the Hellenic National Commission for UNESCO.

He is member of many International and Greek geological and environmental Associations and Societies. He has contributed as coordinator or researcher in more than 25 scientific and applied projects, and also in many studies related with geology, geoconservation, geomorphology, geo-hazards and rural development. He is author or coauthor in more than 50 articles in peer reviewed journals and publications and has participated in many congresses and meetings with about 90 abstract presentations. He participated as co-convenor in several Penrose and scientific meetings, and has organized and participated in many field trips and expeditions in Crete. He has also editorial contribution as reviewer in several journals on tectonics, geodynamics and geoconservation. He speaks excellent English (C1 level) and poor German (A1 level); Additional skills: Authorized Trainer for Adult Education by the National Centre for Training Certification of Greece.
